

**PTSD Resolution Pull Tab Lottery.

1. These Terms and Conditions are the pull tab Lottery terms and conditions. By entering the lottery, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.
2. This lottery is being promoted by and behalf of PTSD Resolution and is called PTSD Resolution Pull Tab Lottery.
3. For the purpose of the Gambling Act 2005, this lottery is defined as a "Society Lottery"
4. This lottery is licensed by the Gambling Commission under the 2005 Gambling Act and is promoted by Colonel A de P Gauvain (Retired), PTSD Resolution, Meadow Cottage Poundfield Road, Chalvington. Sussex. BN27 3TH.
5. The profits made by this lottery are used to support the welfare work of PTSD Resolution.
6. Underage Gambling is an offence, players must be aged 16 (sixteen) years of age over. PTSD Resolution, Dennis Honey, the operating agents or premises operating the machines reserve the right to ask for proof of age.
7. All tickets shall be priced at a £1.00
8. All lottery entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1.00 per ticket to enter the lottery does not guarantee that they will win any prize.
- 9 To accept a prize you must be aged 16 years or over, and we reserve the right to ask for proof of age redeeming any prizes.
- 10 To participate a person inserts the relevant charge into a gaming machine whereupon a ticket will then be issued, showing the name of the game, and game reference. The tabs are then removed to reveal the symbols below. If the revealed symbols match the winning combinations shown on the tickets then you have won a prize.
- 11 A predetermined number of pull tab winning and non-winning tickets are contained in each game.
- 12 Any valid ticket bearing a winning combination entitles its holder(s) to claim from the authorised retailer who sold the ticket, the prize as detailed on the ticket.

- 13 Payment of all prizes on winning tickets is the responsibility of the authorised retailer who sold the ticket to the player.
- 14 All winning tickets are subject to validation before payment. The operating agents or premises operating the machines reserve the right to ask for proof of age.
- 15 All prize tickets must be redeemed before the lottery expiry date. Prizes not claimed before the expiry date will be deemed to be forfeit and will be allocated to the PTSD Resolution fund as a donation.
- 16 By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in promotional activity and PTSD Resolution reserves the right to use the name and address of the winner, their photograph and audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity unless prior notification has been received.
- 17 PTSD Resolution shall not be liable to the player for any loss or damage suffered or arising from playing this lottery.
- 18 Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and PTSD Resolution.

- 20 In the event of any dispute regarding the rules, the decision of shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
- 21 PTSD Resolution reserves the right to amend these rules at any time. If PTSD Resolution does this, it will publish the amended rules at <http://www.ptsdresolution.org/>
- 22 PTSD Resolution reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.
- 23 Each entrant should retain a copy of these terms and conditions for their reference.
